Minutes of the previous meeting – these were circulated in the News Letter and approved at the meeting.

Matters arising from the minutes – there were no matters arising.

Chairman's report – WETS has had a good year which started with Spring Stampex where Jim Wigmore entered our memory stick of WETS Newsletters in the Philatelic Literature Class and winning a Large Vermeil. The April WETS Thematics Day was great success with Sue Burn displaying her "Smithies Bus" exhibit, all about McRobertson Air Race & mail service to New Zealand & Australia. This was followed by our members displays of the Theme 'Be Prepared'. Next year is the WETS Road Show so if you have anything we can display please let Jim Wigmore have photocopies. I hope the coming year will be another successful one for WETS.

Secretary's report – as Chairman's Report.

Treasurer's report - Overall it has been another successful and profitable year for the club. For 2017/18, expenditure is higher (up £64) predominantly from increased room hire (up £20) and refreshment costs (up £37), but this is more than balanced by increased income from higher thematic day bookings (up £72).

The final balance is up £41, which is a similar increase in the account's final balance to that last year.

The overall balance is healthy and there is no need to increase subscriptions.

It was agreed to maintain subs at £6 per member per year and £8 for the Thematic Day bookings. Subscriptions are now due for 2020/21 – see attached form.

Newsletter's report – Producing our newsletter is a struggle as we do not get any input from the membership, we need stories about what our members are working on and about the stories that inspire them to produce thematic displays.
