ZOOM meetings – Our ZOOM meetings are a great success with more and more attendees at each meeting, if you have not yet attended one you have missed some really interesting speakers and displays. Wessex Federation have taken out a ZOOM licence and now hosts meetings for any of its clubs who wish to hold meetings in this manner. This means we are not time limited and details of displays to date are as follows.

11th May 2021 – The first display was British Owls given by Jim Wigmore based upon an extended original 8 sheet display on the same subject it was extended with some addition material as a PowerPoint display, with the Eagle Owl as the Star of the show.

This was followed by a display from our Chairman about Philatelic Fairs at National and International level over several years and the Philatelic Material issued.

A review of our Memory Stick followed with Jim Wigmore showing how it worked and the extension of its material by the addition of the Wessex Newsletters which have been indexed in a similar manner to the WETS Newsletters. This provoked a great deal of discussion that resulted in a motion to add ZOOM displays to the Memory Stick.

8th June 2021 – The first display was “Viaducts” given by



Keith Burton the editor of ABPS News. It contained Viaducts in both the UK and Europe that had been issued on Post Cards and were familiar to Keith as the result of his travels.



This was followed by “The Pilgrim Fathers” given by Jim Wigmore who had been able to extend a subject

previously started by Terry Cowlard. The story covered the period from the Puritans leaving England to go to Holland, their leaving Holland to start a new life in

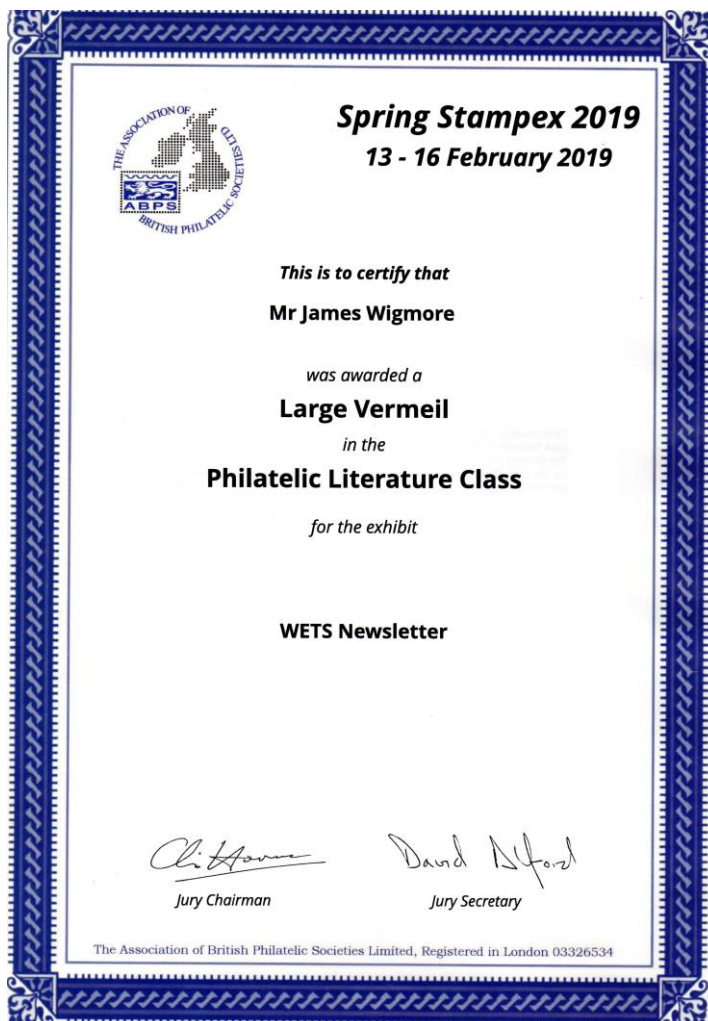




America and the hardships endured by all in this process. A great deal of research was shown gathered from many sources.

This included Postal History from New England showing many districts and place names we would all be familiar with, in some cases the spellings were slightly different e.g. Barnstable as opposed to Barnstaple. This was followed by a demonstration of our “**Memory Stick**” that provoked quite a lot of discussion as the content was seen as very philatelically useful. One of the outcomes of this discussion was a request to add copies of the many ZOOM presentations and the Wessex Newsletters.
